## VIRTUAL WATCH LEADER GUIDE

The purpose of a prayer watch is to hear God in community for current events. We obey Christ's command to "watch and pray" as history enters its most harrowing hour.

- 1. Brevity. Try to keep posts under 50 words. If your content is longer, consider breaking it up into a few posts over a couple of days. Or run it by the leader of the prayer watch as the 'traffic director' who may either re-post your content in an abbreviated form or post the whole thing at a timely interval.
- 2. Frequency. Be mindful of how often you are posting. Limit emojis and GIFs to their best use only.
- 3. Prophecy. One of our primary objectives is to receive real-time communication from the Holy Spirit that inspires fervent prayer and may be uploaded to those we are paying for. We are a radar station for them, reinforcing their faith, courage, love, and hope.
- 4. Encouragement. Look for ways to build one another up in the progress, accuracy, and fruitfulness of our prayers. When our prayers seem to strike the mark, let's celebrate.
- 5. Intel. If you come across helpful information, news articles, maps, etc., send these to the watch leader to be curated and re-posted on the watch channel.
- 6. Gathering Together. Look for ways for two or more to gather and pray in person. Consider the prayer room at the Antioch Office, which you can reserve by contacting.
